Medical Insurance

EUI members must have an adequate medical insurance cover for the entire duration of their stay for both emergency and general healthcare.

Cigna is the reference insurance company of the EUI and provides two different insurance policies:

- ✓ Accident Insurance
- ✓ Medical Insurance



Cigna Group Medical Insurance

Cigna provides a group medical insurance policy covering up to 80% of your medical costs.

- ✓ Some grant-awarding authorities pay the Cigna medical cover to their researchers (and in some cases to their dependents) as part of the grant.
- ✓ In other cases, you can subscribe at your own expense, always benefiting from the special premium rate granted to the EUI members. The enrolment is facultative. The enrolment must be done during the first month of your EUI membership.
- ✓ The <u>Cigna Supplementary Policy</u> provides a higher coverage for hospital care. The enrolment is generally at the expense of the insured.
- ✓ The coverage is valid worldwide, but for the US a <u>supplement</u> is required.

Cigna Accident Insurance

The Institute offers an Accident Insurance policy provided by Cigna (ADD Policy).

EUI active members covered BY DEFAULT are:

- ✓ Ph.D. or LL.M researchers;
- ✓ MRes researchers
- ✓ Post-doc fellows:
- ✓ STG Fellows
- ✓ STG Master students
- ✓ Trainees;
- ✓ Visiting researchers and fellows;
- ✓ Visitors;
- ✓ Children at the day childcare center of the EUI.

The ADD is valid worldwide and also covers extracurricular activities, with some exclusions according to the <u>insurance conditions</u>.

The dependents of the EUI's active members are NOT eligible for this accident insurance cover.

The ADD might not be sufficent to cover all your medical expenses related to an accident. Carefully read the insurance conditions or consult Academic Service for advice.



What shall I do in case of accident?

- ✓ Always provide your emergency contact details before arrival and keep them up-todate during your stay at the EUI via the Academic Service Online Portal <u>my.eui.eu</u>
- ✓ Always keep your EUI card with you for emergency numbers, and a copy of your insurance card or policy.
- ✓ If you are hospitalized/admitted in a hospital, make sure that your medical and/or accident insurance policy is sufficient to cover your costs (if any).
- ✓ If you are a EU citizen in possession of a European Health Insurance card (EHIC), you may receive emergency hospital care free of charge, or by paying just a contribution to the Italian National Health Service (NHS) according to the severity code assigned by the Emergency Department upon admission, instead of paying the costs in full.



The Italian National Health System (NHS)

In some cases, non-Italian citizens can also access the Italian SSN, for example:

- ✓ With the EHIC (European Health Insurance Card), but only for emergency hospital services
- ✓ By directly subscribing to the local NHS branch using the E106 or S1 form, that can be issued in your country of origin under certain conditions (please check your eligibility with the NHS of your home country)
- ✓ By voluntary subscription, paying an enrolment fee

The NHS membership includes all public medical care in Italy, including the GP. Private medical services are not covered by the NHS.

Health Leaves and Parental Allowances for Doctoral Researchers and Post-Doc Fellows

- ✓ Leaves of Absence and Parental Leaves
- A reasoned request should be sent to the Entrance Board at: <u>EntranceBoard@eui.eu</u>.
- A copy of the medical certificate (where appropriate) should be sent by email to the attention of Fatma.Sayed@eui.eu.
- Requests for parental allowances should be addressed to Grants.Office@eui.eu in Academic Service.
- If granted, the allowance will cover up to the equivalent of 4 months of EUI scholarship for biological mothers and 2 months for the other parent.
- ✓ Medical certificates shall be sent exclusively to Fatma Sayed, Academic Administrator.
