



PIERRE WERNER CHAIR PROGRAMME FELLOWSHIP

AT THE ROBERT SCHUMAN CENTRE FOR ADVANCED STUDIES AT THE EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY INSTITUTE IN FLORENCE

In the framework of the Pierre Werner Chair Programme, the Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies at the European University Institute invites staff members of Central Banks to apply for short-term fellowships at the EUI (for a period of time comprised between two weeks and six months). The fellows are expected to be seconded by their own institutions in accordance with their institutions' regulations.

The application should include a description of the research that will be carried out during the stay at the EUI. Topics include economic policies in EMU, the role of Europe in the global economy, governance of the EMU, financial stability, supervision and regulation, as well as other central banking issues.

Selected fellows will be required to reside in Florence for the duration of the fellowship and will be expected to take an active part in the academic activities of the RSCAS. The Centre will provide the fellows with a working space, computer facilities and access to the EUI library.

Applications will be assessed and selected by a committee drawn from among the professors at the EUI and the members of the Advisory Board of the Pierre Werner Chair.

Those interested should send a CV (including a list of publications) and a short outline of planned research (2-4 pages), together with a letter of support from their home institution and specifying the preferred period and length of fellowship to meilan.goei@eui.eu.
