The Florence Report aims to dissect and rethink the EMU's architecture in the light of present-day conditions in Europe and the global economy. We aim to identify avenues for research and policy innovation that foster the advancement of the EMU's stability, growth, and fairness to enhance the resilience of the European Union project by:

- Providing innovative and policy-oriented analysis grounded in academic research.
- Adopting a multidisciplinary approach to foster synergies across and beyond the EUI current and alumni community, applications from <u>all</u> disciplines are welcome.
- Welcoming contributions from academics in all stages of career development.
- Working as a Laboratory of ideas: the EMU Lab will provide opportunities to present and discuss your research in a series of dedicated seminars and workshops.

Submissions should include paper proposals or working papers on topical interests. Preference will be given to early-stage research that would benefit most from the 'laboratory' setting of the project.

Taking 'Fragmentation and Policy Space' as the overarching theme of the 2025 Florence Report, topics of interest include, but are not limited to:

- Capital Market Union
- Single Market
- European Public Goods
- Fiscal Union
- Defense, Security and the Euro
- European Fragmentation
- Institutional and legal dimension of enlargement
- Historical turning points of European integration
