An Open Access (OA) publication or dataset is immediately and freely available online, to read, download, copy, print, disseminate or search. As a publicly-funded institute, our aim is to increase the proportion of research publications and datasets in Open Access. The EUI Open Access Policy encourages its members to facilitate the dissemination of their published research by depositing it with Cadmus.

The EUI Research Repository, Cadmus, registers EUI members' academic publications and datasets produced during their time at the Institute and those based on research carried out here:

- 30,000+ records of which 13,700+ are Open Access
- 3,520 theses of which 1,570 are Open Access



EUI Library Search provides a simple one-stop search for books, journals, articles, chapters, databases, and more.



EUI LIBRARY SEARCH

biblio.eui.eu

Sign in with your EUI account to:

- place a request;
- get full-text access to electronic resources;
- renew library materials;
- request InterLibrary Loans;
- save 'My Favourites' and search history;
- export citations to Zotero and other citation managers.

BORROWING

- EUI members can borrow a maximum of 60 items at a time
- The standard loan period is 30 days. The loan period for each item is listed in 'My Library Account'
- If not reserved by another user, loans may be renewed up to 24 times through 'My Library Account'.

From any EUI computer or from any device connected to EUI Wi-Fi.

Off campus

Sign in with your EUI account using your EUI username and password.

REQUEST INTERLIBRARY LOAN

If the item needed is not available via EUI Library Search, users may request an InterLibrary Loan:

- open EUI Library Search;
- sign into 'My Library Account';
- at the top of the screen click 'Request an InterLibrary Loan';
- complete and submit the form.

BOOK PURCHASE SUGGESTION

If the item needed was published in the last two years, and is not available via EUI Library Search, users may submit a Book Purchase Suggestion Form: eui.eu/research/library/requestforms/bookpurchaserequest

- share logins or passwords.
